


**Monday - April 17 (Day 1): Departure US from LAX, CA to Tel Aviv**

**Tuesday - April 18 (Day 2): Arrival Tel Aviv – Transfer to Transfer to the Dead Sea**

Dinner and overnight at a hotel in the Dead Sea.

**Wednesday - April 19 (Day 3): Free day**

Free day at the Dead Sea - Breakfast and dinner at hotel Included

**Thursday - April 20 (Day 4): Dead Sea - Masada - Ein Gedi - Qumran - Jericho - Sea of Galilee**

This morning we will travel to the rock fortress of Masada the Zealots last stronghold against Rome, Precede to Ein Gedi where David spared the life of King Saul, we enjoy a panoramic look at the desert Oasis to include Davids valley where he David hid. Precede to Qumran where the Dead Sea scrolls were found. Visit Jericho to include Tel Jericho where the ancient city stood at the time of Joshua, view the Mt of Temptations followed by a panoramic tour of Jericho. precede to Tiberias. Check in to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Friday - April 21 (Day 5): Sea of Galilee – Tel Dan - Capernaum**

After breakfast, we take a boat ride, across the Sea of Galilee, while on the boat we will pause for a brief worship service and remember the many miracles our Lord performed in this area. On to Tel Dan at the sources of the River Jordan visiting the ruins of the ancient city to include Jeroboam high place, Israelite city gates, and the 3800 years old Abraham gate. Return to Sea of Galilee. This afternoon we visit Capernaum Jesus home town, Mt of Beatitudes, and Tabgha “peters Primacy” where Jesus multiplied the fish and loaves. Time to reflect and worship on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Saturday - April 22 (Day 6): Megiddo - Nazareth - Cana - Baptismal Site**

This morning we depart for Megiddo that whose history goes back to 3000 BC seeing ruins and remains from the times of King Solomon, King Ahab, and a view over the valley of Armageddon. On to Nazareth for a visit to Nazareth Village a model village of how Nazareth would have looked like at the time Jesus. Carry on to Cana of Galilee for a visit and renewal of wedding vows. We end the day at Yardenit baptismal site along the banks of the River Jordan for the renewal of Baptismal vows. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Tiberias

**Sunday - April 23 (Day 7): Magdala - Mt Carmel - Caesarea - Jerusalem**

After breakfast, start the day with a visit to Magdala the hometown of Mary Magdalene, precede to Mt Carmel “Muhraqa” where the encounter between the prophet Elijah and prophets of Ball took place. on to Caesarea Marittima where we will visit the magnificent city with Roman, Byzantine, and Crusader ruins. We precede to Jerusalem, upon arrival check into your hotel to refresh **before we depart to join the King of King's community for evening service**. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Jerusalem.

**Monday - April 24 (Day 8): Israel Museum - Bethlehem- Shepherd Field – Jerusalem**

After breakfast, we start the day with a visit to the Israel Museum where we see the model city of Jerusalem showing how the city would have looked like in the 1st century AD and the Shrine of the book where the Dead Sea scrolls are on display. On to Bethlehem. Visit Shepherd's Field and then to Bethlehem to visit the Church of the Nativity built over the birthplace of Jesus. Return t to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

## **Tuesday - April 25 (Day 9): Temple Mount – Pools of Bethesda - the City of David - Jerusalem**

On this day we will start visiting the Old City of Jerusalem for the first time and embark on an exciting walk tour, we will enter the old city through Dung Gate and we will ascend the Temple Mount where the Jewish temple stood until its destruction in 70 A.D. Then we will visit the Crusader church dedicated to St. Anne and nearby Pools of Bethesda. On to visit the Jewish quarter seeing the Roman cardo, King Hezekiah's wall, Temple Menorah leading us to the Wailing Wall. On to visit the Davidson Centre "Western wall excavations" and the southern steps that led into the Temple of Jerusalem, also known as the teaching steps where Jesus prayed. End the day with a visit to the City of David. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

## **Wednesday - April 26 (Day 10): Mt of Olives - Gethsemane - Caiaphas house - Via Dolorosa - Garden Tomb**

Start the day with a visit to Mt. Olives; where we stop for a panoramic view over Jerusalem where our tour guide will point to the most important sites in Jerusalem. On to visit the Garden of Gethsemane where Jesus had his agony and was betrayed. There we will pause for a prayer time in the garden. Then, we will visit the House of Caiaphas where Peter denied Christ three times. After that, we will visit Mt. Zion where we stop for a visit to the Upper Room, and the Tomb of King David. This afternoon we visit the Lithostratos "Judgment pavement" where Jesus stood before Pilate, then walk along the Via Dolorosa leading to the Garden Tomb; a peaceful spot where we can remember Christ's crucifixion, burial, and resurrection, the hotel for dinner and overnight.

**April 27 (Day 11): Departure Tel Aviv to the US. Or take the post-tour extension to Jordan.**

## **\*Optional Post Tour extension to Jordan:**

### **April 27 (Day 11): Jordan – Mt. Nebo - Petra**

After breakfast, we will depart to cross the border to Jordan. We visit Mt. Nebo, the place where prophet Mousa (Moses) gazed over the Promised Land before he died. We will visit an old monastery, overlook the Jordan Valley, the Dead Sea, and parts of the Holy Land. Then we continue to drive towards Petra for a traditional Bedouin Dinner & overnight.

### **April 28 (Day 12): Full day Petra – Amman**

After breakfast, we will visit the Site of Petra 2000 years old Nabatean city that was highlighted in the movie "Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade". We will walk through the narrow passageway up to the treasury a massive royal tomb carved out of the solid rock. If time permits we will visit the Traditional Tomb of Aaron (Moses's brother). Afternoon we have a transfer to Amman for dinner and overnight.

### **April 29 (Day 13) - Amman – Jarash**

After breakfast at the hotel, we will visit Jarash, north of the capital Amman. Inhabited since the Bronze Age, it's known for the ruins of the walled Greco-Roman settlement of Gerasa (one of the cities of Decapolis). These include the 2nd-century Hadrian's Arch, the Corinthian columns of the Temple of Artemis, and the huge Forum's oval colonnade.

We then proceed to Amman to meet with and pray with, the local ministry leaders. We will check into our hotel, have dinner, and overnight in Amman.

### **April 30 (Day 14)– Arrive USA**

This morning will have breakfast then transfer to the airport for your flight back to the USA.

**DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS:** A deposit of \$500.00 per person with registration to secure space. An additional payment of \$1,000.00 per person is due on or before **November 20, 2022**. The final payment due on or before **February 20, 2023** Payment can be made by personal check or money order.


