2022 was another fantastic year for DJJ:

1. 18 Partnership Trainings held worldwide with 579 in attendance
2. **28 Volunteer Partnership Team Staff**
3. 15 Headquarter Staff and Volunteers
4. **83,058 New Disciples and 9 New Countries**
5. 556,488 Lives Impacted (**an estimated 695,440 lives have been impacted to date!**)
6. 879 Certificates of Completion given to disciples (individual quarters)
7. **81 New Testament Quarters 1-4 Certificates of Completion given**
8. 68 Holy Land Videos recorded for 34 Old Testament Journeys and 20 other videos
9. **5 New Languages released (DJJ now offers 20 languages online)**
10. 1 Partnership Training Material completed in English, 1 translation completed
11. 16 New Testament Quarter 2 Translations completed
12. **1 Website created for Spanish**

In addition, we strive to practice great stewardship of the funds donated. In 2022, for every \$1 donated, 76.6% went back into Programs, 13.7% to Management/General, and 9.7% to the cost of Fundraising.

What will 2023 bring? It will be even more of the same: more disciples, languages, countries touched, leaders, and most importantly, more lives impacted by Christ through DJJ discipleship.

New Website in Spanish!

In December, we soft-launched a new website that provides a dedicated site to reach Spanish speakers, djjministryspanish.org.

Spanish is the second most used language in the world in terms of native speakers. 534 million speak Spanish, comprising nearly 8% of the world's population.

We are grateful for this accomplishment from our Spanish translator, Donald Dolmus, Joe Tran Media Group, and Patty Hansen, who led the project.

The main website, djjministry.org, will still offer all the journeys in all translations. In addition, DJJ also offers djjministryportuguese.org for those who speak Brazilian Portuguese.

DJJ anticipates adding another heart language website as funding is available.



Materials Department Update

DJJ offers what we think are two of the biggest tools in multiplying discipleship using the DJJ lessons:

1. **Partnership Training.** This training introduces disciple-makers to DJJ and the journeys. Some of those **disciple-makers are called to become makers of disciple-makers and join the DJJ Partnership Team as Ambassadors.** The final version of the Partnership Training Materials was put on the website for the team in October. This project culminated several years of writing, editing, testing, and reworking the sessions. Now, Spanish has been translated, tested, and will be released soon.

Please pray for the funding to translate additional languages into this key training. (\$5,000 per language)

2. **Translations.** Having the DJJ journeys translated into the languages people are looking for is a priority. While the goal is to have the lessons in the world's major languages, **the focus is to have all of the journeys available in the heart languages of disciple-makers committed to making disciples.** This focus is why DJJ offers lessons in some of the lesser-known languages.

In 2022, New Testament Quarter 2 was translated into 16 languages: Ateso, Bengali, Burmese, Chichewa, Chinese, French, Hindi, Kirundi, Luganda, Odia, Portuguese, Runyakitara, Russian, Spanish, Swahili, and Tagalog.

We are eager to start these translators in Quarter 3 soon! Please pray for the translators, the design team, and funding. (Approx. \$2,000 per language for each quarter.)



Deadline to Join is Soon! DJJ's 2nd Israel Pilgrimage


Learning, walking, hearing from others, and moving forward is our natural Journey in Christ. I got to know Christ this way.
