



Many Opportunities to Connect with DJJ

There are several ways for you or your church and ministry leaders to connect. **See the next page for more information on dates and how to attend, some are not offered at this time.**

1. Intro to DJJ

This 30-minute information meeting is a great first place to find out more about the DJJ ministry and the discipleship materials offered.

Who should attend? Anyone who wants to hear about the DJJ ministry and lessons.

2. Discipleship MasterClass

This 2-hour MasterClass goes deeper into DJJ's *Process of Discipleship* and the compelling reasons to go from a disciple to a disciple-maker. Participants also go through a lesson.

Who should attend? Anyone interested in discipleship and unsure where to start.



3. QuickStart

In this 2.5-hour class participants are introduced to four topics, Mentoring, Prayer, Bible Study, and Stewardship to start their discipleship journey.

Who should attend? Anyone needing their next step in discipleship. This is an excellent way for a church or ministry to kick off its discipleship program!

4. Partnership Prayer Meeting

This monthly time of prayer is only 45 minutes but is so impactful. Those participating can meet others around the world and join in prayer. The list is sent out after the meeting, and you can receive a copy by signing up on our website.

Who should attend? Anyone who wants to pray for the DJJ ministry.

5. Partnership Training

In-person trainings are held worldwide in many locations. A Headquarters-led online training is held every few months as well. The training generally lasts for 8 hours.

Who should attend? Anyone who wants to move from disciple to disciple-maker, especially church and ministry leaders.

6. Discipleship Challenge

This is a commitment to do the first four journeys and see how God can speak to you and others.

Who should do this challenge? Everyone!
