



Four Opportunities to Financially Partner with DJJ

Dear Friends.

Last fall, we shared a huge God-sized financial goal that would allow DJJ to accomplish all we believe He has led us to achieve in 2021. Since then, as you know, travel has been restricted in many places where we had planned to hold Partnership Training Events and develop future leaders. We have been able to use Zoom effectively to lead online trainings. However, we have been hindered by not meeting leaders face-to-face who might join our Partnership Team Staff, so we are praying that opportunities to travel will happen this fall.

Additionally, we been able to release more lessons, which creates the need for more translations of those lessons.

I was delighted when a friend recently asked me, "I know it is vital to have the DJJ lessons translated into other languages. What does it take financially to make that happen?"

The answer is that it takes \$1,000 per quarter, and since there will be eight quarters when completed, it takes \$8,000 per language. He is praying with us about this expense and how the Lord will provide.

Will you please also pray and consider if God might have you be part of the answer by giving to this need? And not only that need, but the other expenses of this worldwide ministry.

When we announced our special needs for 2021, people responded wonderfully. We shared a God-sized goal of \$259,000, of which \$90,700 was provided in 2020. This means that \$168,300 is still needed! Would you consider helping meet this need?

Ministry Value Number Six: Pleasing Jesus

So far, we have introduced you to:

• Value One: Strategic Partnerships.

We provide a resource for strategic partners to multiply disciples.

Value Two: Ministry to the most spiritually needy.

We focus on providing free digital materials where they are most needed.

Value Three: Excellence.

We seek to be the best we can and do the best we can for the Lord Jesus.

Value Four: Spirit and Truth.

We minister in the power of the Spirit and faithfulness to the teachings of Scripture.

Value Five: Stewardship.

We recognize that we do not own anything; it all belongs to God.

Now, let's consider the final ministry value.

Value Six: Pleasing Jesus. We live to please and glorify the Lord in every way.

What this means: DJJ is not about me, it is not about us, it is not about accomplishments, it is not about being "successful" in people's eyes, and so on. In the end, our goal is simply to please and glorify the Lord Jesus. That is it.

The Scriptures say:

- 1. "So we make it our goal to please him" (2 Corinthians 5:9a, NIV)
- 2. "Our purpose is to please God, not people." (1 Thessalonians 2:4b, NLT)
- 3. "Our goal is to measure up to God's plan for us." (2 Corinthians 10:13b, TLB)
- 4. "No one serving as a soldier gets involved in civilian affairs—he wants to please his commanding officer." (2 Timothy 2:4, NIV)
- 5. "Am I now trying to win the approval of men, or of God? Or am I trying to please men? If I were still trying to please men, I would not be a servant of Christ." (Galatians 1:10, NIV)

Living to please the Lord and not ourselves or others is sometimes challenging, but also comforting since...

- As believers, we have just one person to please: The Lord! This is a cure for people-pleasing stress.
- As believers, we have just one job to do: Whatever the Lord wants us to do! This is a cure for time pressures.
- As believers, we have just one concern: Pleasing the Lord! This is a cure for all sorts of uncertainties and fears.

We want to be like Jesus who said, "And He who sent me is with me. He has not left me alone, for I always do the things that are pleasing to Him." (John 8:29, ESV)

We recognize that one day "Yes, each of us will give a personal account to God." (Romans 14:12 NLT) Jesus' Journey to the Judgement Seat of Christ (New Testament Quarter 4, Journey 51) studies what the believer can expect when they stand before God to give an account of their life.
